Hello,

Thank you for inquiring about our Companion Obedience Dog classes. I am looking forward to meeting you and your canine friend. I have enclosed a brochure and contract for you to be able to get to know us better. To help us be prepared for the first class please fill out both of the contracts keeping one for your own information and send one back to us. Sending a contract and payment ahead of time helps us free up time at the first class to allow for questions that you might have about your canine friend and us, although it is not necessary to attend class. If you are unable to send payment at this time and would like to just send your contract, payment can be made at the first class. There is a pre-addressed envelope to 3909 Orchard Street, Walworth NY, 14568 that have been added for your convenience and is the mailing address for Companion Dog.

Beginner Classes have been set to start on a Thursday September 17th at 7:30. Please indicate on your contract which class you will be attending. We try to keep the class size at no more than 10 dogs. Socialization is important to all ages of dogs. If this date is not convenient please call to learn when other classes are being scheduled. Payment for Beginner Classes is normally \$115.00 for an eight-week class session. We have a coupon for \$5.00 in the newspaper so the payment for this class is \$110.00. Each week will be an hour class. There are three instructors plus myself to insure you get individual attention. In class we go over a class-training sheet that you will be able to take home and go over with your dog during the week following class. After the Beginner Classes we offer other classes to continue your dogs progress. They can be paid nightly at \$25.00 or \$115.00 for eight classes.

Please have your dog on a flat snap collar. If another collar is needed to train your dog we offer them at class or will suggest where you can purchase them. A 6-foot cotton lightweight lead is necessary. Cotton is softer to your hands. If you are unable to find one we will have them at class or again suggest where you can find one. Country Max and other pet stores usually stock 6-foot cotton web lead and flat snap collars.

All dogs need to bring proof of rabies if your dog is old enough to have been vaccinated. Rabies is required by state law and needs to be up to date. Other dates of inoculation that are necessary to insure the safety to other dogs in the class and given at eight weeks is (DHPP) Distemper and Parvo. Bordatella is given at the age your veterinarian recommends.
